June.24,2017	Up-grade facilities in Hostel	<p>Provided extra facilities for Hostel students August 27, 2017 onwards, in which 20 Wall fans, 10 Exhaust Fans costing of Rs. 43,011. 6 Geysers costing of Rs. 26,100, 10 Almirah's costing of Rs. 85,500 and 2 Water Coolers costing of Rs. 1, 72,000.</p> <p>A Doctor from Vedanta Hospital visits college campus for weekly health check-up of the hostellers and they get benefits of free medicine health check-up. Students, who come through Hindustan Zinc Ltd. Are allotted free hostel facility, computer course (RKCL), books & all educational facilities.</p>

	Allotment of Mobile phones at free of cost to students	<p>The management allotted 2636 mobiles phones to students at free of cost on Jan.03, 2018. The purpose of this allotment was to develop better communication in rural areas and inform the parents about important events, activities, Univ. exams, college fee and scholarship; and to aware parents regarding their wards' attendance and studies.</p>
	Management decided to increase seats in Science faculty on demand of students.	<p>The no. of seats was increased from 120 to 180 in the faculty of Science (Biology) for the benefit of the students.</p>
	Management decided to start new livelihood & development Course.	<p>Under RSLDC program Facial Therapist course started from June 2018. In the first batch 30 students got benefit of this course from which 17 students are now self-employed.</p>

	Strengthen the feedback mechanism through Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS).	The college, under IQAC, regularly collects the feedback from the students and other stakeholder. Received suggestions and ideas collected through feedback shown to Principal & management and immediate actions are taken to resolve the concerned issues. It was found that the standard of education is continuously increasing. On the basis of the Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2016-17, a feedback report was prepared. The management decided to improve upon the points in which students' satisfaction level found to be low during 2017-18.
	<p>Management decided to provide more financial support to the students, who are meritorious, financially weak, belonging to sports category, and fatherless.</p> <p>Management decided to provide financial assistance to the hostellers.</p> <p>Management decided to give financial assistance to encourage the students (Under RS-CIT course).</p> <p>Increasing no. of students received scholarship from Central & State Govt.</p>	<p>Total 461 students have been allotted increased budget of Rs. 5,55,710/- as financial assistance to students.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 2,03,000/- was provided as financial aid to 29 students residing in the hostel.</p> <p>Total no. of 21 students was given Rs. 13,650 as financial assistance which is Rs. 650/- per student.</p> <p>In this session 725 students benefitted under scholarship scheme by the Social welfare Department and Under the Chief Minister's Higher Education Scheme.
